## **Speaking for land owners**

- 'Landowners' are often taken as a group, but it's never that simple.
  - Land owners are a diverse bunch
    - Traditional private land owner, Communities, NGOs, Institutional, large corporates/banks...
    - Problematic to refer to 'landowners' or as if they are a single category
    - Different land owners have different objectives
    - The same land owner might manage their land for multiple goals

- Owners / managers will always be thinking about the bottom line
- Core of 'traditional land uses'





## Land owners and ecosystem services

How do land owners work with ecosystem services concepts?

- ◆ They don't (on the whole)
- ◆ They rear livestock, grow crops, produce timber, they manage for wildlife...
- ◆ Ecosystem service concepts are part of a policy/academic discourse
- But once explained they see themselves as delivering





## Land owners and ecosystem services - implications

- Start from where your audience is (as opposed to attempting to bring them to you)
- Take time to understand the ways that land owners think about land management and how your concepts of ecosystem services fit with their view of management and their business objectives
- Look for complementarities rather than broad behaviour change

- Opportunities for dialogue/collaboration


